## Batons & Handcuffs Safety Training Course

### Skill Set Requirements

- CPPSEC3110 Control persons using batons
- CPPSEC3111 Restrain persons using handcuffs

This skill set describes the skills and knowledge required to safely and effectively carry and use batons and handcuffs.

### Target Group

This skill set is suitable for licensed security officers and crowd controllers who are responsible for protecting the safety and security of people, property and premises using batons and handcuffs.

### Pathways Information

This skill set may provide credit towards CPP31318 Certificate III in Security Operations and CPP31418 Certificate III in Close Protection Operations.

### Batons & Handcuffs Permits

This course will qualify the candidate to then apply to Firearms Registry for a Batons and Handcuffs Permit to carry batons and handcuffs when required and authorised by their current security employer.

The licensee will then need to apply to the NSW Police Force Firearms Registry for a Batons and Handcuffs Permit.

This training does not result in a Batons and Handcuffs Permit.

## Physical capabilities

The physical requirements of a Security Guard need to have the ability to deal with various security threats and challenges and perform physical tasks on a daily basis. For instance: ejecting a person from property who may be causing harm to a person or property/assets; perform first aid and good vision to have a strong sense of observation. The role often demands quick responses to particular situations and the ability to move quickly; and the physical ability to work on your feet for a whole shift patrolling sites or positioned at a gate checking people in and out or even running in emergencies.

Physical fitness enables you to handle these situations effectively. Strength and endurance are critical to your daily duties. Security Guards must be vigilant and attentive, constantly scanning their surroundings for potential threats or suspicious activities.
